Funded through a gift from Art and Betty Kellar, Inova Kellar Center has provided mental health and substance use disorder treatment and Special Education services to thousands of children, adolescents and families since 1991. The Kellars envisioned a treatment center that would understand the unique needs of children and adolescents and provide services in the context of the family. In partnership with Inova Health Foundation, Inova Kellar Center committed to developing and providing services that would be covered by health insurance and other third party payment options, while creating a safety net for children and families without the resources to access the care they needed. This unprecedented commitment to the community is a reflection of Inova's concern for and dedication to children and families facing significant mental health challenges.

Philanthropy is at the heart of Inova Kellar Center's ability to successfully meet the needs of children in our community. With seed funding from the Kellar Family Foundation, the Center will expand services into Loudoun County in late 2017 to address the significant gap in available mental health services for children in that community. Services provided will include a Partial Hospitalization Program, an Intensive Outpatient Program and therapy. Additionally, two Child and Adolescent Psychiatrists have been hired to provide medication management and psychiatric consultation to families. This expansion is possible due to the Kellar Family Foundation and the continued commitment of our many other supporters.

United Bank's commitment to the Classic is a reflection of their concern for the children and families struggling with mental health and substance use disorders throughout the community. Partnerships such as the United Cardinal Classic move communities toward better outcomes for children, regardless of socio-economic status.
